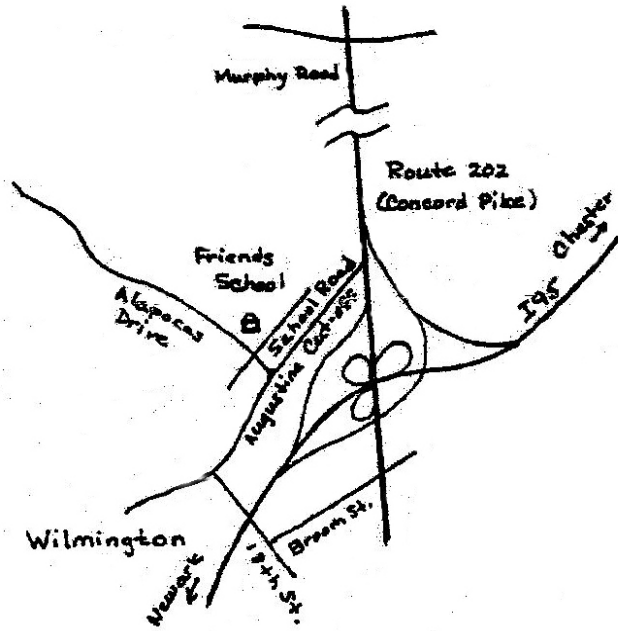

Note for people coming by I-95 from either direction:

You cannot get to Augustine Cut-off easily from the Route 202 (Concord Pike) North exit. Instead, take the Concord Pike South exit. Turn right at the bottom of the hill onto North Broom Street. Follow North Broom Street to the end and turn right onto West 18th Street. It will curve under a railroad bridge and end at Augustine Cut-off. Turn right onto Augustine Cut-off, then left onto Alapocas Drive.
